

## ORDINANCE NO. 761

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF BOONEVILLE  
 IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE CITY OF WALDRON TO FORM A PUBLIC FACILITIES  
 BOARD: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Booneville has established that an emergency exists regarding future water needs and,

WHEREAS, the City Council in August 2000 showing approval of a joint effort between Waldron and Booneville in seeking an additional source of water approved the City of Booneville's portion of a Feasibility Study of Site 3 as a regional water supply and,

WHEREAS, the Feasibility Study has been completed by McClelland Engineering and now the time has come to form a Public Facilities Board to oversee the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOONEVILLE, ARKANSAS:

## SECTION I.

The Mayor of Booneville is hereby authorized to expend the necessary funds not exceed Twenty-Five Hundred Dollars ( \$2,500) in seeking legal assistance needed to form, as part of a joint effort with Waldron, a Public Facilities Board to oversee the Regional Water Supply Project.

## SECTION II.

The Mayor of Booneville is also authorized to make any decisions needed in forming of the Public Facilities Board on behalf of the City of Booneville, ie. name of board, appointment of members to represent Booneville, Logan County.

## SECTION III.

Time being of the essence an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
