


BOONEVILLE CITY COUNCIL  
Ordinance No. 2009 - 857

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY OF BOONEVILLE, LOGAN COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED:


AN ORDINANCE REGULATING LARGE ANIMALS AND FOWL IN THE CITY OF BOONEVILLE, ARKANSAS, ESTABLISHING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BOONEVILLE, ARKANSAS, THAT:

- Section 1:** Definitions: "Large Animal" means any bull, steer, cow, horse, mare, gelding, colt, mule, ass, sheep, swine, llama, or goat. "Fowl" means any chicken, duck, pigeon, turkey, goose, pheasant, or guinea.
- Section 2:** Any person that has five (5) adjoining acres or more inside the city limits is exempt from this ordinance, except section 4; "NO SWINE SHALL BE ALLOWED IN THE CITY."
- Section 3:** Minimum space to keep a large animal is 20,500 square feet for the first animal and 23,600 feet for each additional animal.
- Section 4:** No swine will be allowed in the City.
- Section 5:** No person keeping large animals shall permit them to run at large.
- Section 6:** No person keeping fowl shall permit them to run at large. The person allowing their fowl to run at large will be cited to court and the judgement may be to remove the fowl from the city limits.
- Section 7:** Odor and unsanitary conditions will not be allowed.
- Section 8:** Violation of ordinance, first offense \$35.00, second offense \$60.00, third offense and subsequent offense shall not be less than \$100.00 and not more than \$300.00
- Section 9:** This ordinance being necessary for the public peace, health, comfort, convenience, morals, safety and welfare of the City of Booneville, Arkansas, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force from the date of this approval.
