

BOONEVILLE CITY COUNCIL
Ordinance Number - 887

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BOONEVILLE, ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED:

“AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PEDDLERS/TRANSIENT MERCHANTS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS TO BE LICENSED BY THE CITY OF BOONEVILLE PRIOR TO SELLING USED GOODS AND/OR NEW GOODS NOT PREVIOUSLY SOLD AT RETAIL, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES”

NOWHEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BOONEVILLE, LOGAN COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS:

Section I: This Ordinance shall be known and titled as “The City of Booneville, Arkansas, Peddlers/Transient Merchants Ordinance.”

The Booneville City Council adopts this Ordinance to require peddlers/transient merchants to be licensed by obtaining a permit from the Booneville City Clerk prior to selling used goods and/or new goods not previously sold at retail.

1. The license fee for such permit as set forth is to be one hundred dollars (\$100) per year, or five dollars (\$5) per day for each person selling used or second-hand goods, and fifteen dollars (\$15) per day for each person selling new goods not previously sold at retail. Said fee is to be paid to the City Clerk/Treasurer prior to the issuance of the permit.

The fee for the permit shall not apply to Logan County residents who sell, peddle or hawk fruit or vegetables that they have grown themselves.

It shall be unlawful to operate within the city limits without a license. Such action will be considered a violation and will be subject to fines of up to \$50.00 per day for each violation.

Section II: In the event any title, section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, subparagraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the Ordinance.


Section III All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section IV: That this ordinance be necessary for the protection of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect

from and after its passage and approval by the Booneville City Council.
