

ordinance no. 918

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE PURCHASE AND OUTFITTING OF VEHICLES FOR THE BOONEVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Booneville desires to procure said vehicles through Landers Ford who is the State of Arkansas Bid Holder for said vehicles and to immediately outfit said vehicles;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOONEVILLE, ARKANSAS THAT:

Section 1: That the City Council of the City of Booneville, Arkansas hereby authorizes the Mayor to purchase five (5) vehicles from Landers Ford for the state bid price and upon purchase have them immediately outfitted.

Section 2: That the City Council of the City of Booneville, Arkansas hereby waives competitive bidding for the purchase and outfitting of said vehicles.

Section 3: It is hereby ascertained and declared that there is a great need for new police vehicles in order to promote and protect the health, safety, and welfare of the City and its inhabitants. It is, therefore, declared that an emergency exists and this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate of public peace, health and safety shall be in force and take effect immediately from and after its passage.
