BOONEVILLE CITY COUNCIL Ordinance No. 925

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BOONEVILLE, ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 887 REQUIRING PEDDLERS/TRANSIENT MERCHANTS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS TO BE LICENSED BY THE CITY OF BOONEVILLE PRIOR TO SELLING USED GOODS AND/OR NEW GOODS NOT PREVIOUSLY SOLD AT RETAIL, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BOONEVILLE, LOGAN COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION I: This Ordinance shall be known and titled as "The City of Booneville, Arkansas, Peddlers/Transient Merchant's Ordinance.

1. The license fee for such permit as set forth is to be twenty-five dollars (\$25) per year, or five dollars (\$5) per day for each person selling used or second-hand goods, and five dollars (\$5) per day for each person selling new goods not previously sold at retail. Said fee is to be paid to the City Clerk prior to the issuance of the permit.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE: That this Ordinance be necessary for the protection of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
